

The criteria for judging are wide-ranging and flexible. We are interested in environmental achievements across the community. Potential entrants and nominees will be assessed on their level of awareness, commitment, action and achievement, within the following four categories:

Awarded to the individual who, in the opinion of the Trustees, has, during the past year, through personal commitment and application made the most outstanding contribution to the protection or enhancement of Jersey's environment.

Awarded to the business organisation that, in the opinion of the Trustees, has, during the past year, demonstrated the greatest commitment to environmental best practice. Particular focus will be given to environmental strategy embedded into the company's business practices.

Awarded to the public sector, voluntary or other non-profit making organisation that in the opinion of the Trustees has, during the past year, demonstrated the greatest commitment to achieving high environmental standards.

Awarded to the individual (under 21 years of age) who, in the opinion of the Trustees, has during the past year demonstrated the greatest passion and enthusiasm for Jersey's environment.

A Committee of the Trustees will select the winners and present their awards at an award ceremony, the date and time to be advised.

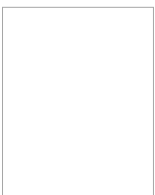
